

I-75 Tournament

2019 Rules of Competition

Player Eligibility: Players must be properly registered with a club and must be properly rostered for the 2018-2019 season to be eligible. Players must have all appropriate safety equipment.

Team Eligibility: RECREATIONAL All-Star teams only and each player must be registered with a club for the 2018-2019 season. Player passes **ARE** required for 10U-15U age groups. All teams must have an Event Roster or Team Roster. Coaches must be properly registered with a club and must have a valid Coach's pass.

All teams must check in with the Tournament Officials 1 hour prior to their first game with:

(3) copies of their Team Roster and Player Passes (10U-15U age groups) for each player and coach

Tournament Play:

Standings in a group shall be determined by **GAME POINTS:**

3 Points for a Win

1 Point for a Tie

0 Points for a Loss

1 Bonus Point for a Shut-Out Win

Forfeit recorded as a 4-0 score

No Shut-out point is awarded for a forfeit win or a 0-0 tie

Seeding for Bracket Play:

Group play will be determined by random draw.

If two or more teams have the same number of points at the end of group play, the team that advances will be determined based on the following tiebreakers:

TIE BREAKERS:

- 1) Head to head competition; if no clear winner then
- 2) Net goal differential (max. 4 per game); if no clear winner then
- 3) Least goals allowed; if no clear winner then
- 4) Goals scored per game
- 5) Kick from the penalty mark per FIFA Rules

Semi Finals and Finals:

If game is tied at the end of regulation time, U10-U15 will play two 10 min. **Golden Goal** overtime periods.

If game is still tied, teams will take kicks from the penalty mark per FIFA Rules.

- For 10U teams, the kicks will be taken 8 yards from the goal line
- For 12U teams, the kicks will be taken 10 yards from the goal line
- For 15U teams, the kicks will be taken 12 yards from the goal line
